Enjoy "a day on the ranch" in East Beaver Valley and experience the crisp Colorado mountain air, wildflower-covered meadows, pristine canyon land and welcoming hospitality.

Located south of Pikes Peak just 17 miles from The Broadmoor, the century-old Elk Glade Ranch hosts events from 12:30-6:00 p.m. (check our schedule for days). Chartered vans will take you directly from The Broadmoor to the ranch — sit back, relax and take in the scenery on this 45-60-minute ride, traveling the historic Old Stage/Gold Camp Road that follows the route of the old mining railroad. It was this route that President Theodore Roosevelt referred to as "the trip that bankrupts the English language."


